1. What is the name of the teacher?
2. Approximately, how many students are in the class?
3. At, approximately **1:45** in the video Ms. Elliot tells the students the “blue-eyed people are the better people in this room.” How did the students react to this initial statement of superiority of blue-eyed people by Ms. Elliot?
